Chateau De La Condamine Corbieres 2004 13.5% Volume €25.00
Big, almost brawny blend of Grenache, Syrah and
Mourvedre with a peppery nose, lots of fruit and plenty of round tannins.

Chateau DiAumiere Saint Jean Coteaux Du Languedoc €28.00

2004 13.5% Volume

Stylish, elegant, ripe red made by a reformed merchant banker.

CHILE

Vina Perez-Cruz Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 2005 14.5% Volume €35.00

Dense, concentrated Cabernet with pure blackcurrant fruit and oaky finish. One of Chile's best wines.

ITALY

Zenato Valpolicella Ripassa 2004 13.5% Volume €35.00

A halfway house between Valpolicella and Amarone from one of the great producers of the Veneto. This fine wine is produced from the grapes Corvina and Rondinella grown on the hill north of Verona.

PORTUGAL

Duas Quintas Douro Reserva 2001 13.5% Volume €75.00

Possibly the best Portuguese red wine: very low yield, impeccable winemaking, fitness and concentration.

SOUTH AFRICA

Warwick Estate Cabernet Franc 2004 14% Volume
Highly unusual red from top Cape estate. Wonderful ripeness
combined with real freshness.

Dominus Napanook 2002 14% Volume
Mainly Cabernet, made by Christian Moueix of Chateau
Petrus in the Napa Valley, California. One of California's great wines.

LEBANON

Chateau Musar (Serge Hochar) 1999 14% Volume
Acclaimed in 1984 as the Decanter's Man of the Year.
He produces wine of real vigour and quality.

CHAMPAGNE

Alexandre Bonnet Champagne

This trophy winning wine is made with Chardonnay from the Cote des Blancs and is blended with Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier to offset its intrinsic richness with more delicate floral overtone. A champagne of finesse.

Louis Roederer Champagne

Brut Premier is the embodiment of Louis Roederer style, combining all the fruitiness and freshness of youth wine with the vnosity of a fully mature wine, with a lively attack and a smooth palate. Blend ; 56% Pinot Noir, 34% Chardonnay and 10% Pinot Meunier. Aged in oak casks 2 – 6 years.

Louis Roederer Cristal

Cristal is made according to the strictest criteria, based on a drastic process of selection applying to the vintage, the cru, the village, the grapes and finally the wines. Only Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes from the House's 10 most celebrated crus are used in the production of this legendary cuvée.

De Venoge Cordon Bleu

Cordon Bleu Brut Champagne reflects all then properties of the house of Venoge itself. It is the product of a careful selection of over 60 different Crus of Vineyards – 25% Pinot Meunier, 50% Pinot Noir and 25% Chardonnay and this blend is aged over 3 years.
